GTAA District 333 ratifies new collective agreement

The membership of the Greater Toronto Airport Authority (GTAA) has ratified their collective agreement by 89.5 per cent.

The 3 year collective agreement will be in force until July 31, 2016 and features improvements such as:

- Wage increases of 2.75% effective August 1, 2013, 2014, and 2015
- Increased standby and shift premiums
- Consolidated Group Insurance /Pension Plan(s)
- Improved dental and long term disability
- Paid bereavement
- Contracting out - Job protection and employer disclosure
- Expedited grievance and arbitration process
- Improved protection for employees facing discipline

“Solidarity was a key factor in this round of bargaining,” commented CAW Local 2002 President Jamie Ross. “When the membership supports their bargaining committee and their union, they make significant progress.”
