

Instructions from the Canadian Red Cross for those members and their families directly impacted by the wildfires.

## Canadian Red Cross Response in British Columbia:

- At the request of the Ministry of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness, the Canadian Red Cross in partnership with the Regional District of Central Okanagan is providing accommodation support (in form of group lodging) to help people impacted by the fires in the Central Okanagan region.
  - In partnership with the Regional District of Central Okanagan, a Red Cross Reception Centre at Prospera Place (1223 Water Street, Kelowna) is available for people that have been impacted by the wildfires.
